Dates: Saturday, July 29, 2023 (NA) & Sunday, July, 30, 2023 (UPT/UT)

*Registration for both test days opens at 8:00 am MST on March 22 (for members) and 8:00 am MST on March 26 (for non-members) - early emails will not be accepted.

Test Registration: Complete, in full, the test entry form (saved as a pdf) and email it to northpointtestsecretary@gmail.com no earlier than 8:00 am MST on **March 22** (for members) or **March 26** (non-members) - early emails will not be accepted.

**All dogs must be registered with NAVHDA International and all Owners and Handlers must be NAVHDA International members in order to be eligible to test in a NAVHDA event.

After we receive your test entry form, you will be sent a confirmation email and invoice. Payment must be received within 48 hours of receiving your invoice in order to secure your spot on the Test Roster. Registrants that do not pay within 48 hours of receiving their invoice will be removed and placed at the bottom of the waitlist. **Test registrations are processed on a first come, first served basis.**

Incomplete test entry forms or forms with errors will not be processed until they are fully completed or corrected.

Final running order will be randomly selected and released closer to the test weekend.

Waitlist: If the test is full, you will receive an email notifying you that you have been put on the waitlist. The waitlist is filled on a first come, first served basis upon receipt

of a completed registration form. You may ask to be removed from the waitlist at any time by emailing northpointtestsecretary@gmail.com.

Withdrawals due to dog illness or injury may be eligible for a full refund pending licensed veterinarian documentation and will be handled on a case by case basis.
